Green Update

During the off season, the work doesn't stop and the Lawn Rangers have been hard at work preparing the green ready for the new season as well as completing other jobs in and around the clubhouse.

Thank you to *Richard* for this update:

As soon as the green closed in the Autumn, plans were executed, machines were prepared and orders placed for grass seed and top dressing.

The green was scarified, cleared of debris and spiked before new grass seed was sprinkled and brushed into the green to ensure even distribution across the green. Once the grass seed was embedded, the green was top dressed with over 2 tons of sand and loam! The green was watered before a contractor came and carried out a deeper method of spiking called Verti Draining.



Notes on watering the Green

At the end of the 2021 season, the majority of you will be aware we had the green re-worked by an outside contractor at considerable expense. Consequently, in 2022, we commenced the season with effectively a new bowling surface. Simultaneously we experienced the sixth driest summer on record since 1836 and the driest since 1995. You will appreciate we have to give the new green every chance for it to survive and prosper, hence the higher use of water than normal.



Conversely in a wet season, we have no control over the volume of water going on to the green and this can also affect the bowling. However, during a "normal" season we endeavour to use water as and when necessary.
